TUNGSTEN PROPERTY IN NCA Minerals Corporation intend to use the \$60,000 net proceeds
B.C. IS TO BE EXPLORED of the firm underwriting detailed in GCNL 238(77) to make the
first payment under the agreement to acquire the Gotcha mineral
claims detailed in GCNL 239(77), being \$3,000; to pay outstanding accounts payable of
\$20,000; to conduct the program described in 14 Sep 77 report of J.P. Elwell, P.Eng., on the
Gotcha claims estimated at \$25,000; to pay bank loan of \$10,000 and to provide \$2,000 to-
ward working capital.

Mr. Elwell reports that the Gotcha ^{previously called} claims of 10 metric units lie 20 miles NE of Clear-
water, B.C. Access is by way of highway north from Kamloops to Clearwater and 25 miles
of good all weather logging road to the property.

Previous exploration by Union Carbide Ltd. in 1972 and 1973 outlined two zones of high
grade scheelite mineralization with an estimated total potential of 15,000 s.t.u. WO₃.
The ground was restaked by United Mineral Services Ltd. in 1977 and some additional strip-
ping and geological studies were carried out.
