Dimac prepares BC mine for November start-up

Production is scheduled to begin early
November 1981 at Dimac Resource

Corporation's new Silence Lake tungsten
mine near Clearwater, BC. Construction
of the 110 ton/day mill is now almost
completed and most of the deposit has
been stripped of overburden. Access
roads have also been completed to the
property. The company estimates current
ore reserves of 53,000 tons grading
1.47% tungsten trioxide.
