BULLDOZER TRENCHING AND DRILLING PLANNED - K.E. Wickstrom, president of Rampart Mines Ltd., FOR GEOCHEMICAL ANOMALIES AT DUFFEY LAKE has reported that the proceeds from the recent financing of 200,000 shares underwritten at 78¢ each by West Coast Securities Ltd, Feb. 21, 1980, will be used to explore the 18 Crown granted Silver Queen claim group about 15 miles east of Duffey Lake, 85 miles northeast of Squamish, B.C. Work will start as soon as weather conditions permit. F

The claims cover areas containing values in gold, silver, lead and zinc. A geochemical survey between the east and west creeks of the west fork of Cottonwood Creek has shown areas of anomalous lead, zinc and silver. Exploration is required to define open pit limits and grades over an area 3,000 feet long and 3,000 feet wide.

The East Creek has been trenched for a length of 400 feet and showed mineralized brecciated rocks with sheet-like bodies of massive and disseminated galena and sphalerite. One sample across 18 feet assayed: 0.02 oz. gold/t, 35.4 oz. silver/t, 12.01% lead, 18.33% zinc. A composite grab sample assayed: 0.02 oz. gold/t, 16.1 oz. silver/t, 10.48% lead, 2.28% zinc.

A gossan zone exposed 2,200 feet southwest of the East Creek trench assayed, over a width of 16 feet, 0.01 oz. gold/t, 0.9 oz. silver/t, 0.01% copper.

D.C. Malcolm, P. Eng., has recommended bulldozer trenching, bulk sampling and preliminary drilling.

EXPLORATION PROGRAM TO - A follow up program of trenching, sampling and preliminary drilling ENTER THE SECOND PHASE of the geochemical and geophysical anomalies in the area of massive and disseminated gold, silver, lead, zinc mineralization is now under way on the 18 Silver Queen claims on Cottonwood Creek near Lillooet, B.C., which are held by Rampart Mines Ltd. The program will test an area 3,000 feet by 3,000 feet between the east and west creeks of the West Fork of Cottonwood Creek. F

The East Creek has been trenched for a length of 400 feet and showed mineralized brecciated rocks with sheet-like bodies of massive and disseminated galena and sphalerite.
