Dear Sir:

In answer to your letter of May 3 re technical information to be submitted.

I returned a completed form re "Annual Census - Metal Mines - 1973" several months ago. This contained the information relative to the mineral contents of a car of ore shipped from the Providence Mineral Claim in October /73.

The "Providence" Lot 618 is a Crown Granted Mineral Claim situated in the Greenwood Mining Division.

The mineral deposit is a quartz vein containing Gold, Silver, Lead and Zinc and for all intents and purposes is mined out. Both shafts are caved at the collar and the underground workings, most of which are under water, are inaccessible.

The fifty-five tons I shipped last year was screened and sorted out of the Providence waste dump. At the present time I am doing some sampling to ascertain whether I can get enough values to make another shipment.
