AN IRREGULAR FRACTURE ALONG A CONTACT BETWEEN DIORITE AND SCHISTOSE ROCKS, WHICH STRIKES NORTH-WESTERLY AND STEEPS DEEPLY TO THE NORTHEAST, CARRIES SMALL LENSES AND VEINLETS OF HIGH GRADE SILVER ORE. ONE SMALL SHIPMENT WAS MADE TO THE TRAIL SMELTER DURING THE YEAR. A CROSSCUT TUNNEL, ABOUT 75 FEET BELOW THE SURFACE EXPOSURES, DID NOT INTERSECT THE MINERALIZED STRUCTURE.
