EARLY WORK PLANNED ON GOLD CLAIMS - Two separate claim groups have been staked by Granby Resources Ltd. in the area NEAR EUREKA, NEVADA & GREENWOOD, B.C. of Eureka, Nevada, to cover gold potential prospects. Angus L.J. MacDonald, president, reports that, before acquiring the properties, the company conducted a program to review the regional geology, plus reconnaissance soil sampling, which yielded encouraging values in an area of favorable alteration and structure.

The first group of 36 claims is in White Pine county, 8 miles east of Eureka. The second group is of 46 claims some 15 miles west of Eureka. It is planned to start a program of geological mapping and soil sampling as soon as possible.

Elsewhere, work will start on Granby's Greenwood, B.C. gold-silver properties by about 15 July 85.

Granby is seeking additional capital with which to accelerate these programs as well as expand its regional exploration programs.
