The company has provided an assortment of data which is not specifically designed as a feasibility report, hence it is voluminous and ambiguous. The geological data (exhibit III) is adequate, but no more. For example, no surface or level maps, only two sections are provided. The geological report otherwise seems competent and we have no evidence to doubt the modest reserves claimed (ca. 250,000 tons @ 7.8 oz. silver/ton of all categories). Unfortunately since Neil McKecknie retired we have no geologist who knows the mine at first hand.
