vein 120/28 S. No sulphides. True small 40'
to 5' same attitude
Upper Vigilant level. vein 120/28 S. 1-2' or 3' closely spaced
veins 3 inches to total of 3 ft thick. Vein qtz is late. Galena
sphalerite pyrite on walls of vein. Vein qtz in center

at face vein 145/75 SW. 6-8" vein qtz. Little or no
sulphides 30-40' from face 8-10" coarse galena on FW
6-8' from face pyrites again in face. Rare in marbles.
uniform bed blocky.

Mined width in this adit is less than 3 feet. probably some
replacement out of but not followed in mining & may be 1/2' on
each side of fracture.

Lower level. H vein. at part 3' wide 6-8" coarse galena
on FW. (S well) 2-3" on N. Center all beautiful white qtz & talc
veins in center filled with fluorite.

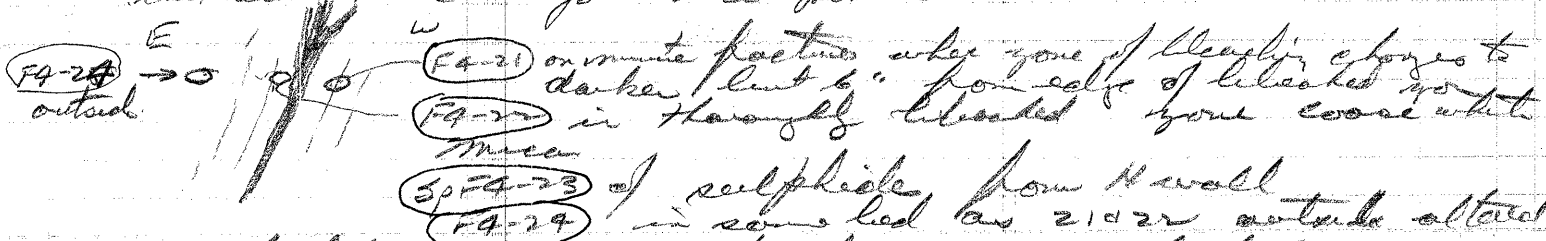

(A) last fracture on NW of lamp dyke 100/605 at union base mineralized fracture part of the. Contains pyrobitite coarse galena v. jaggy calcite dentulate fracture pattern. Dyke bleached for 4-6" on each side of 2-4" sulphide zone (Sp F4-19) of veinlet of sulphides in bleached dyke. (F4-20) from center of dyke - uniform fine grained center rounded white clots up to 1/2" across (calcite) 2-6" sphonite margin on FW side. Vein material on NW side up to 2' wide - series of fracture no zone on spacing though closely spaced fractures in HW of dyke in adjacent long adit.

(B) Coarse galena in fracture to 3" wide in center of zone with 10-12 ft fracture. (6 on dark side) 75/725 pyrobitite + sphalerite + bleached walls. In 4' of beds. This up a down vein but wall yellow surface? composition



Face of adit is 85 pe north of cone. 50' back (5) zone from face to raise into adit @ C vein 100/725 smoothed zone several feet wide most sulphides in 6"-1' FW fracture - in certain (?) beds - as seen on E. Works woolly. C. in adit very numerous calcite - filled fracture locally v. jaggy of calcite + minor dark sphalerite. At face 105/705. Some vein in #1 adit below 105/655 1" calcite + fluorite. 5 tight veinlets over length of 4' led. of 6'. One vein has minor sphalerite pyrite.

E side of canyon. small fracture 90/705 40 pe S of adit opposite (C) other fracture in bluffs to N or W side of canyon should be photographed - vein. Also on to #2 adit.

#2 adit 115/725 18" jaggy of calcite fluorite + coarse galena, dark sphalerite

There are 7 veins + branches exposed in continuing cliffs on W side woolly canyon between this and vein in #2 adit. Seem to be more from here S to vein on lamp dyke.
