MODERN TECHNIQUES ARE BEING USED TO EXPLORE OLD GOLD MINE - Ewing Oil Corporation crews are working on the Firebrand silver-lead-zinc property in the Slocan mining division on the west shore of Kootenay Lake, 3 km south of Ainsworth, B.C. Robert S. Rosenblat, director, says work done previously at two locations in the main shaft, at 21.55 feet and 44 feet, yielded average assays of 22 ounces of silver per ton, 4% lead and 7% zinc.

In November 1983, Ewing Oil's geologist, George P. Krueckl, engaged in some preliminary prospecting and sampling. Several old pits which were located ran as high as 1.4% lead, 13.7% zinc, and 8.50 oz. silver/t.

Mr. Rosenblat says the current work program includes geochemical, magnetic and V.L.F. electromagnetic surveys as this property has never been drilled or explored by modern methods. Any new targets that are uncovered will be trenched by backhoe.

Ewing Oil will be successful in raising over \$150,000 in their initial public financing. The company's shares were called for trading on Vancouver Stock Exchange on Oct.3/85.
