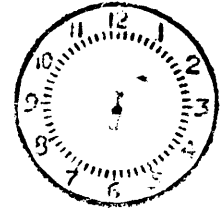

Mr. Syd Berisoff of Silvertown, B.C. has phoned me and advised that he had received your letter of November 9, 1978, referring to a grant covering the Adit Project of the aforementioned property. He was elated with the news and gave me the following information:

1. They had already proceeded with the project commencing October 9, and by October 31st had completed about 45 feet of tunnelling.

2. He and Mr. J. Mellen worked together during October, and Mr. John Anderson was hired in November.

Due to very limited finances and no income ^{year} to date, I would request that you consider the following cash flow controls:

1. The principals of the company (Berisoffs) are payrolled at reduced rates in order to preserve cash for other purchases and expenditures. Only necessary cash is taken to fulfill their needs.

2. Mr. Mellen is payrolled at a reduced rate and he has been living off his own resources without pay as per working agreement.

3. All other individuals are fully paid.

4. The reason for reduced payrolls in 1 and 2 above was necessary for making funds available for the payments of the payroll deductions, Workers Compensation and other expenditures.


5. The payrolls will be adjusted to the intended amounts when finances become available.

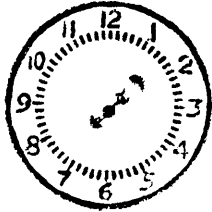
