BULLETIN No 1 - 1932: narrow qtz fissure-vein in coarse feldspathic granite  $\rightarrow$  several hundred feet on surface, 200' underground. At places (notably near the portal), qtz is banded & well mineralized across 3-6" with pyrite carrying the gold values. 3 bars of sorted ore from a small stop near the portal returned \$67 per ton net. SAMPLES IN THE STOP & across the vein at various places indicate about \$15 / ton. gold. vein is persistent, var. form in width, strike, & dip.
