FORMER GOLD PRODUCER IN - Subject to regulatory approval, Julia Resources Corporation intend
 B.C. IS BEING ACQUIRED to acquire the former Chapleau Mine on Lemon Creek, 5 miles SE of
 Slovan City, 15 miles NW of Nelson in S.E. B.C. President Giovanni
 Camporese says the property comprises 3 Crown granted mineral claims - the (Chapleau, Seuttle
 and Corker) and 20 mineral claims surrounding them.

W.G.Stevenson, P.Eng., reported 22Feb80 that mineralization was discovered and staked
 on the NW side of Chapleau Creek in 1896. A stamp mill was erected to which the ore was
 transported by tramline. The mine was inactive from 1904 until 1932 when lessors took over
 operations. Over a two-year period they produced a few tons of ore and shipped it directly
 to the Trail smelter. The property has been inactive since 1933. B.C. Department of Mines
 records show production from this mine from 1896 through 1941 was 326 tons averaging 2.90
 oz. gold and 40.1 oz. silver per ton. Mr. Stevenson states: "This property holds consider-
 able exploration attraction and warrants detailed geological mapping, sampling, drilling and
 possibly underground development may be warranted."

Elsewhere, says Mr. Camporese, one oil well in the Dawson leases in Rogers county, Okla-
 homa, is being completed and should be in production by 30Nov80.
