- several shaft tunnels 10-20' below surface,  
along a length of 200-300'. A main  
tunnel was driven <sup>15'</sup> 30' below these on a  
broken "lead" which "in places exhibited  
van considerable bodies of Pb carbonates  
& iron oxides." "Solid formation did not  
seem to have been reached in any  
of the workings." Colaba said there  
as high as 600 oz Ag. A 15 ton  
shipment returned 200 oz; A 45 ton  
lot returned 150 oz.
