The first assay results have just been received from the phase II drilling program covering the top section of DH87-9 where the following intersecitons were encountered:

Type A, a higher grade type, has been indicated by drill sections of up to 38 feet grading 0.148 oz. gold/t (Hole 87-3). *82FNW233* More drilling is required to determine a tonnage.

Type B, lower grade type, has been indicated by a drill intersection of 0.055 oz. gold/t over 202 feet (Hole 87-3). While it is too early to assign overall grades a size potential of 10,500,000 tons is inferred.

Mr R.W. Robinson reports: *S.W*
The company has received a report on the Great Western project in south east BC. In this report Salazar states there is the potential for a deposit in excess of 200,000 tons grading 0.15 oz/ton gold. *82FNW233*

In late October the project was reviewed and drilling to date has indicated the potential for at least 2 types of targets:

Type A, a higher grade type, has been indicated by drill sections of up to 0.148 oz/ton gold over 38 feet; more drilling is required on this type mineralization before a tonnage calculation may be completed. *NOV 16 1987*

Type B, a lower grade type, has been indicated by drill intersection of 0.055 oz per ton over 202 feet. While it is too early to assign overall grades a size potential of 10,500,000 tons is indicated.

Within the type A higher grade zones, mineable widths of high grade have been encountered:
