I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT THE ABOVE INFORMATION IS SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLETE AND CORRECT TO THE BEST OF MY

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 2nd day of February, 1974, between the I.X.L. GOLD MINING & MILLING COMPANY of Tacoma, Washington, U.S.A., first party (hereinafter called the "Owner"), and J. AIMIE RUELLE, of Rossland British Columbia, second party (hereinafter called the "Lessee"),

WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

(1) In consideration of the covenants, by the Lessee, contained herein, the first party, as owner of the I.X.L. Mineral Claim, Lot Six Hundred Seventy-nine (679), located in Township Nine (A), Trail Creek District, together with surface rights, (which mineral claim and surface rights are hereinafter called the "Claim"), hereby leases to the Lessee the said Claim from the first day of April A. D., 1974, for a period of two (2) years, ending the last day of March A. D., 1976.

ROYALTIES PAYABLE

(2) In consideration hereof, the Lessee shall pay to the Lessor a minimum rental of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per month, in advance, on the first day of each and every month. The Lessee shall also pay to the Owner a royalty of 25% of the net smelter returns on all ore concentrates from the Claim. The term "Net Smelter Returns", hereinafter used in this Agreement, means the amount by which the total revenue from each specified lot or specimen of ore, produced from the Claim by the Lessee, exceeds the outlay for the smelting and treating of same. It is also agreed that Lessee, in remitting to the Lessor, shall deduct from royalty payments due the Lessor the minimum rentals of \$10.00 per month previously paid; and not exceeding a total of \$240.00 over the period of this lease.

Ore shall be defined as any material, metallic or nonmetallic, containing valuable constituents for the sake of which it is mined or worked, and shall specifically include, but shall by no means be limited to, gold, silver, platinum, sulfur, nickel, copper, cobalt, uranium and iron.

The Lessee shall cause a statement of all smelter settlement sheets to be delivered to the Owner, also the Smelter shall be notified of the terms of this lease in order that they may deduct royalties and forward them direct to the Owner. Shipments of ore, including all high grade accumulations, shall be made to Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company of Canada, not less than once each month.

INCIDENTAL RIGHTS

(3) For the purpose of carrying out this Agreement, the Lessee shall have the right to take and hold exclusive possession of the Claim, to erect buildings and install machinery thereon, and to explore and develop the Claim and win, take and turn the ores thereof to account.

VARIOUS COVENANTS BY THE LESSEE

(4) The Lessee agrees to the Owner as follows:
(A) That the Lessee will do and record such assessment work, and shall comply with all laws and regulations of the Province of British Columbia, the Dominion of Canada and other governmental

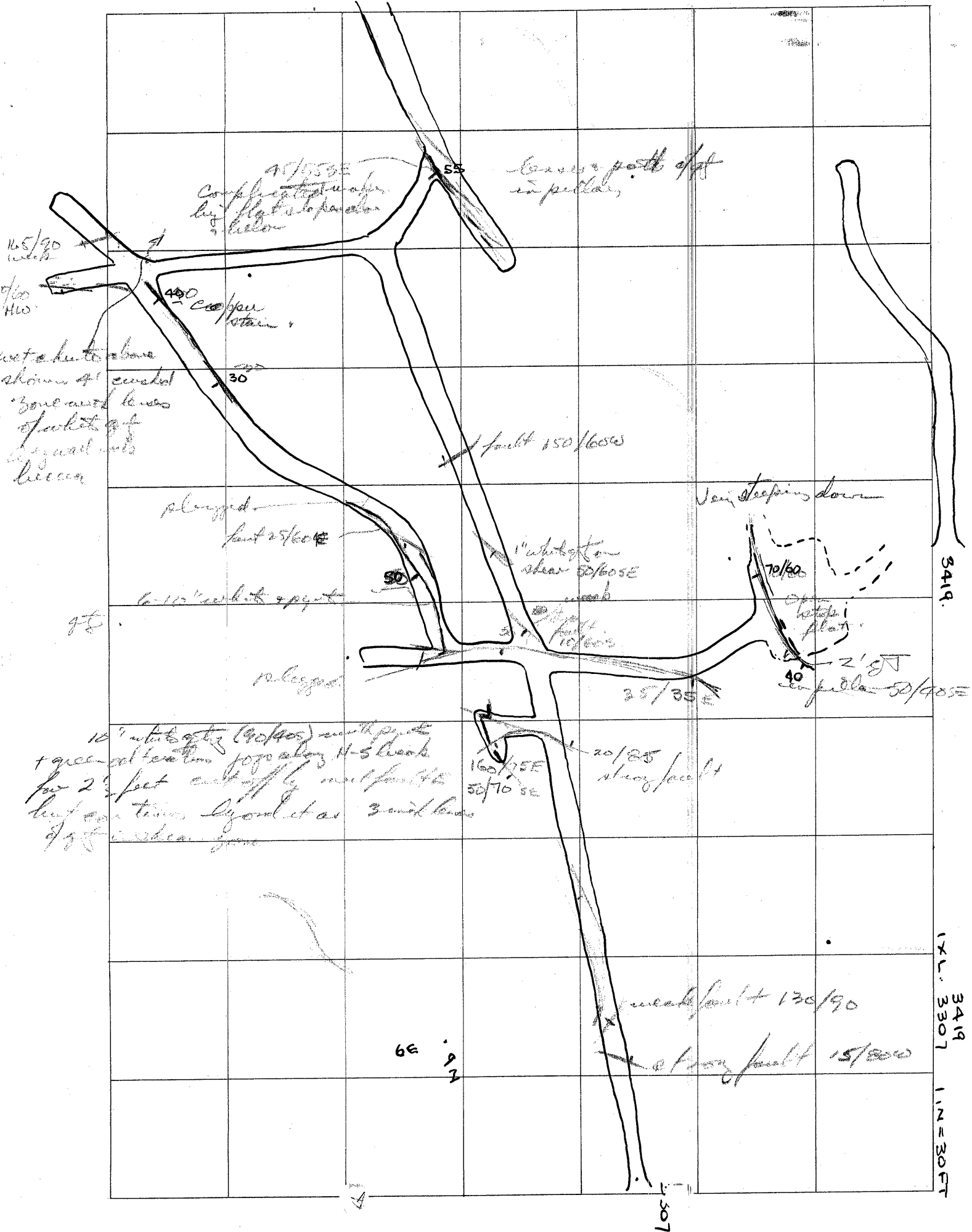

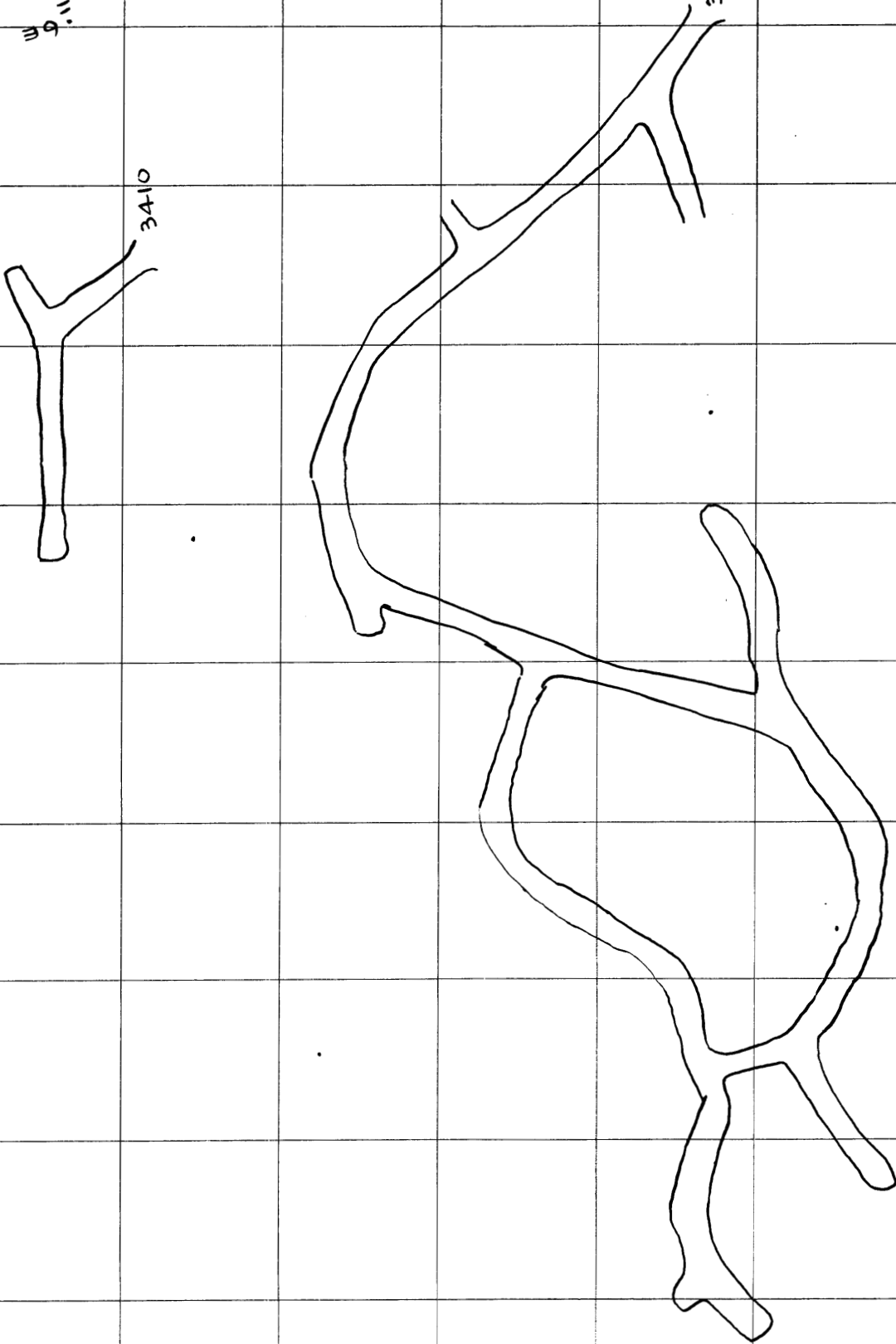
