A major program is intended. Extotal have a signed a management contract with E & B Explorations Inc. who will conduct all exploration work for the company. In announcing this, Extotal president G. Barry Mann reports that E & B's exploration manager Leonard W. Saleken, has been appointed as a director of Extotal.

Extotal have signed an agreement whereby John M. Mirko can earn 60% in Extotal's Aspen silver property in the Sheep Creek camp near Salmo, SE B.C., by spending \$420,000 over four years. Previously Extotal drilled out proven reserves of 55,000 tons grading 6.85 oz. silver per ton over an 11.17-foot mining width and indicated reserves of 550,000 tons of about the same grade. Mr. Mann says Mr. Mirko has informed the company of a new showing 300 feet above the previously explored silver zones. This showing is exposed over 15 feet long and 3 feet wide; one grab sample assayed 54.8% lead, 20.55% zinc and 5.62 oz. silver per ton and another assayed 0.26% lead, 30.20 zinc and 0.09 oz. silver/t.
