**ANOTHER GOOD HOLE - R.W. Robinson**, president of Lectus Developments Ltd., reports that exploration of the Great Western group of claims 8 miles south of Nelson, B.C., is "progressing well and assay results are very significant." (SEE table above and GCNL 220(87)p.3). Lectus' property interests range from 51% to 100%. The company has signed an agreement with First Exploration Fund 1987 and Company, Limited Partnership for an additional private placement of 125,000 shares at 80¢ each to raise \$100,000 for further drilling.

Lectus has signed an agreement to acquire an option on the North Star crown grant which covers the major regional shear zone immediately south of the company's drilling activity. The option would require Lectus to pay \$14,000 a year for 8 years to acquire the property.

A channel sample of a recently discovered vein outcropping 150 feet south of DH87-3 on the newly acquired North Star claim assayed 0.114 oz.gold/t over a 10-foot section. Drilling started on the North Star claim on 27Nov87 to test at depth this recently discovered outcropping.

Lectus opened the old Starlight mine adit 2000 feet south of DH87-3. A channel sample taken along the adit wall yielded significant gold geochemical values and, just before the main drift, a 6.5-foot channel sample from a quartz vein assayed 0.486 oz.gold/t, 0.36% copper and 1.23 oz.silver/t.

Assay results from Holes DH87-11, 12, 13 and 14 are expected over the next 2 weeks.

Lectus will start their work programs on the Great Western and Ogg properties 6 miles SW of Nelson, B.C., immediately. Work on their Dieppe II property in NW Quebec is to start in the fall when the program could be guided by results of the extensive drilling work now being carried out by the Inco Golden Knight joint venture along Lectus's northern property line.

FOLLOW UP PROGRAM PLANNED - S.R.Ford, P.Eng., director of Lectus Developments Ltd.,

has reported assay information from a recent soil sampling and wall rock sampling program on the Nelson, B.C. Great Western claims. The wall rock samples are from the dump of the lower audit and one sample from a pyrite-bornite veinlet assayed 1.632 oz.gold/t. The soil sampling program was conducted on a 20 meter by 50 meter grid and the 140 samples taken covered an area approximately 500 meters by 250 meters with high anomalous gold values.

The company will continue the exploration work and has scheduled an induced polarization survey and a trenching program this fall to identify drill targets. New funding is sought.

Mr S.R. Ford reports:

The drilling program on the Great Western property near Nelson, BC has been shut down temporarily because of unseasonal rain. Drilling is scheduled to resume in the first week of January 1988.

The latest drilling results designed to test to the north of discovery hole 86-1 has shown substantial geochemical anomalous gold in all holes. The section being tested is on strike and the distance between the two groupings of drill holes is 600 ft. The more significant intersections are as follows:

Drill holes 87-6, 17, 18, 19, 20, and 21 are logged and have been sent for assay. The later holes were designed to test the outcropping on the North Star crown grant.

The company has acquired a substantial contiguous property position south and west of its previous position in the Nelson area. The company has signed a contract with a group to acquire two crown grants and 13 claims known as Black Witch, Tough Nut, AG, AG1, to AG5 inclusive and Whiskers 1 to Whiskers 5 inclusive. The terms of the option are advance royalty payments of \$90,000 and the issuance of 200,000 treasury shares over a three-year period.

PROGRESS ON B.C., CALIFORNIA - Lectus Developments & QUEBEC PROPERTIES REVIEWED Ltd.'s executive vice president S.R. Ford, P.Eng., M.B.A., reports that with the \$465,000 proceeds of two private placements, the company is continuing exploration on its Great Western property near Nelson, B.C. The trenching and road building program is well advanced and is scheduled to be completed by Christmas. A 2 shift, \$60,000 drilling program will start on 18Dec86 and is projected to be completed by Christmas. The first reports on the program should be ready early in the new year.

Early in January, the \$117,000 exploration program will begin on Lectus' property in the Casa Berardi gold camp in Quebec. This program will be headed by Guf Salazar S., P.Eng., and will be designed to complement the extensive program being carried out on the contiguous Inco-Golden Knight property.

In California, Lectus has engaged Dr. Barry Hillman to prepare an assessment of Lectus's Golden Key property on the Mother Lode vein structure just north of Coulterville on Highway 49. The report will be ready for publication soon after 9Jan87.
