

REVELSTOKE PROPERTY - Fleck Resources Ltd. shares started trading on Vancouver Stock Exchange 3Aug84 following receipt PROGRAM UNDERWAY of \$200,000 from a primary offering.

Work has commenced on the Silver Dollar property in the Revelstoke area of B.C. Access road upgrading has been completed and drill sites have been established. Diamond drilling and additional trenching will commence within the next few days. The first drill hole is spotted south of the old mine workings in the vicinity of several trenches, with silver, gold, zinc, lead and copper which has a gross value of \$350 per ton over a width of 7.5 feet and known length of 350 feet.

There were 531 tons of ore produced from this zone in the years 1901 to 1917. Smelter returns show an average of 88.5 ounces of silver per ton, 0.01 ounces of gold per ton and 33.7% lead. No credits were given for the zinc and copper in the ore.

John P. McGoran, secretary, said the company is seeking acquisition of precious metal and oil and gas projects.

Ltd. (see table). he reports also that 390 feet east of the first drill site, where holes 84-1 to 84-3 were drilled, a well mineralized zone 6.5 feet wide was uncovered while establishing another drill site. This zone appears to have the same mineral assemblage as the Gilman vein 1700 feet northwest. The Gilman vein had smelter returns of up to 2 ounces of gold per ton in addition to silver, lead and zinc values.

Drilling will start on this new zone within the next few days.
