Premier Resources Ltd. secretary Andrew J. Kallquist has reported that a second phase of exploration has been recommended for the McAllister Mine, a silver property located 12 miles east of New Denver in the Slocan Mining Division of B.C. In his report of July, 1975, George L. Mill, P. Eng., concluded that although the vein varies both as to width and silver content, there are numerous locations where selective stoping operations could be carried out on an economical basis. The recommended second phase of work is reopening the No. 6 Level plus mapping, sampling and shipment of dump ores to the smelter. (See GCNL NO. 198, 165 and No. 151 for previous reports).
