


CORES FROM FIRST HOLES NOW - Fred Marchard, president of Mar-told Resources Ltd. has reported IN FOR ASSAYING - RESULTS of 5 holes has been completed and the No.6 diamond drill EXPECTED ABOUT OCT.15,1982 hole is now drilling on the property of the company which MEMDOW MOUNTAIN is located adjoining to the claims under exploration by LaTeko Resources Ltd. and Esperanza Explorations Ltd. The first five holes have tested a zone of pyrite and arsenopyrite which is exposed in a trench from which in 1981 the prospector shipped 200 tons assaying 0.721 oz. gold per ton. Holes No.1 and No.2 were from the same location but at different angles and cut the zone at 260 and 360 feet below surface. Cores from these two holes have been logged as similar to the material exposed in the trench and have been split and submitted to assay. Results are expected to be available about Oct.15,1982.

No.3 holes is 100 feet NE of No.1 and No.2, while No.4 is 100 feet further and No.5 200 feet further to the northeast. No.6 is 300 ft. iE of No.5 and 600 ft.NE of No.1.

Brican Resources Ltd. has located two claims in the Tillicum Mountain district, south of Nakusp in SE B.C. The claims cover more than 1500 acres.

Brian Fagan, president, says these claims were located on the basis of a geological setting similar to that of the La Teko - Esperanza gold discovery. Brican has completed preliminary prospecting and a geochemical reconnaissance survey and is awaiting analytical results.

ASSAYING CONTINUES - Drillcor Industries have now completed No.6 hole on the Hountain Meadows gold claims of Mar-Gold Resources Ltd. in the Tillicum Mountain area (see map overleaf page 2). The exploration program on these claims sought to delineate a zone of pyrite and arsenopyrite by drilling. Holes No.1 and No.2, which were drilled to 260 feet and 360 feet below the surface, were angled and, although not showing by themselves sign. ificant values of gold, will be evaluated in conjunction with holes 3,4, 5 and 6. These later holes were spaced 100 to 300 feet apart.

In reporting this, president F. Marchard says that over the next two weeks A.C.M.E. Labor-

atories are expected to have these assay results available.

Meanwhile, ongoing surface exploration has yielded overall positive indications of a large silver, lead, zinc showing in the south side of the claims adjoining David Minerals and a large porphyry molybdenum-copper showing in the northeast claims section.

Elsewhere, in Frio county, Texas, testing continues on the Morales No.1 well which was successfully drilled past the Austin Chalk to the Buda zone. Fracturing of the well was conpleted Oct.15/82, so results will be known shortly.
