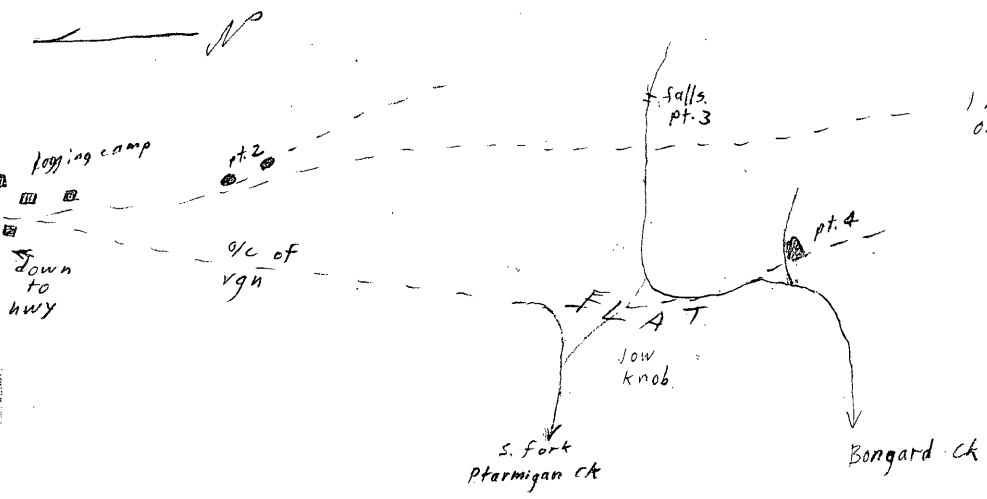

To Zettergreen's higher showings

1. Zoned dk gray banded silica, etc carbonate & some qz, trending 080°. May cross country f. Carbonate in spots like porphyry - sp. 2. tr of Cu. Drive to logging camp (deserted)
2. S. of logging rds, abt 500' above camp - vein ∇ in sil. country rock. 100' up upper rd to patch of tremolite, which may be a bldg, beside amphibole gneiss bedrock.
3. Cross Bongard ck then follow up E side to falls - sev qz veins along f., which dips NE, with indef sil. borders - no appar. mineral, but tr of Cu reported.
4. Down Bongard ck to a tributal lower rd - exp. of limonite cementing rubble frags of arg or sl; small arg exp. above, where ∇ appar. 020° to W.
