

To Zettergreen's higher showings

1. Zoned dk grey banded silica, etg carbonate & some qz, trending  $080^{\circ}$ . May cross country f.n. Carbonate in spots like porphyry - sp. 2. tr of Cu. Drive to logging camp (deserted)
2. Sc of logging rds, abt 500' above camp - vein P in sil. country rock. 100' up upper rd to patch of tremolite, which may be bldr, beside amphibole gneiss bedrock.
- Cross Bongard Ck then follow up E side to falls - several qz veins along f.n., which dips NE, with indef sil. borders - no appar. mining, but tr of Cu reported.
4. Down Bongard Ck to a trib at lower rd - exp. of limonite cementing rubble frags of arg or sil; small arg exp. above, where it appears  $020^{\circ} \text{ to } 70^{\circ} \text{ W.}$
