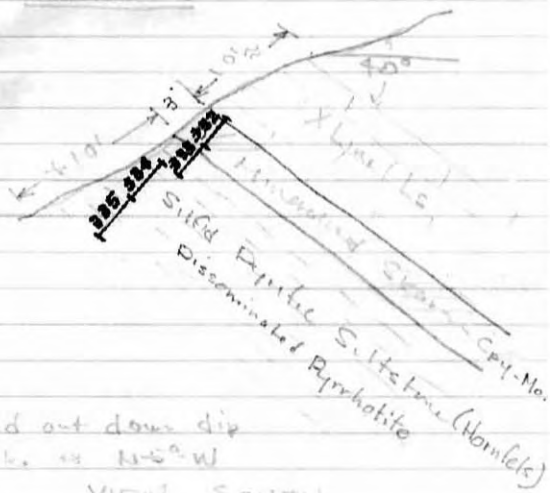
DESCRIPTION: Min. occurs in 1 mi. x 1 mi. 'window' of Cacho Creek side, exposed by erosion of Kamloops (Tertiary) volcanics. Small intrusion of Upper Mesozoic diorite also exposed along N side of window. Late pegmatite phases also intrude sediments. Sulphides are associated with two parallel bands of crystalline limestone trending N-S and dipping 40-60° W. and separated by 500' of barren siltstone or argillite. Min. occurs along foot wall of ls. horizon in contact zone of skarn minerals underlain by siltstone mineralized with pyrite over 10-15' thickness. Pyritic beds weather to give rusty zone which assists in tracing favourable horizon on surface. Min. is coarse, rosettes of MoS_2 alone or with Chalcopyrite. Fracture & discontinuous. Cpy. as seams or disseminated blebs in granular skarn zone. Ls beds appear to roll, steepening from 50° W for 40° to 60°

RECOMMENDATIONS:

No work is recommended on this property. Average grade is much too low to support med. tonnage operation with slope widths of say 10-15' and high grade zones are to evolve for systematic mining

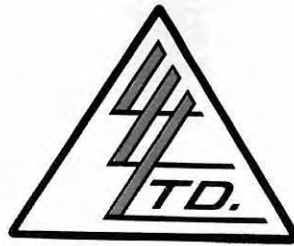
