## SUMMARY 1965 EXPLORATIONS

### Rock types in staked area

Phyllite / quartz - Secoite - shist.  
Chlorite shist to hard glassy chlorite rock ..  
Course quartzite through fine argillitic quartzite  
to banded limey rock, interbedded with  
Quartzite and Limestone  
Sills and Dykes? of Acid Intrusives ..  
Greenstone and one known intrusive of  
an Amphibolite.

### Mineralization

Bands of Pyrrhotite to 40 ft. wide, with  
low grade copper lead & Zinc, some bands  
or flows? With exception of a few chips  
completely replacing field rock to  
widths up to 10 ft. .. Pyrite in some  
areas usually with better copper values.

### Best values out with 1965 drilling

#### Ruth claims

2 1/2 ft. assaying Gold .01 .. Silver 4.2 ...  
Zinc 8.84 .. Lead 4.71 .. Copper .17 ..

#### North Lake Area.

21 ft. Zinc .55 .. Copper 1.57 ..

1 - 12 ft. band assaying  
Gold .02 .. Silver .1 .. Copper 2.57 ..  
with close lying 3 ft band assaying  
4.84 Copper ..

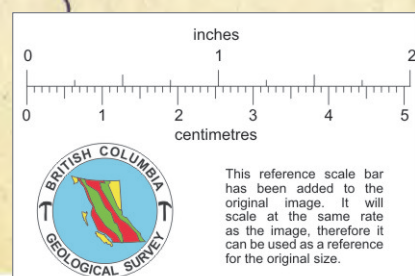
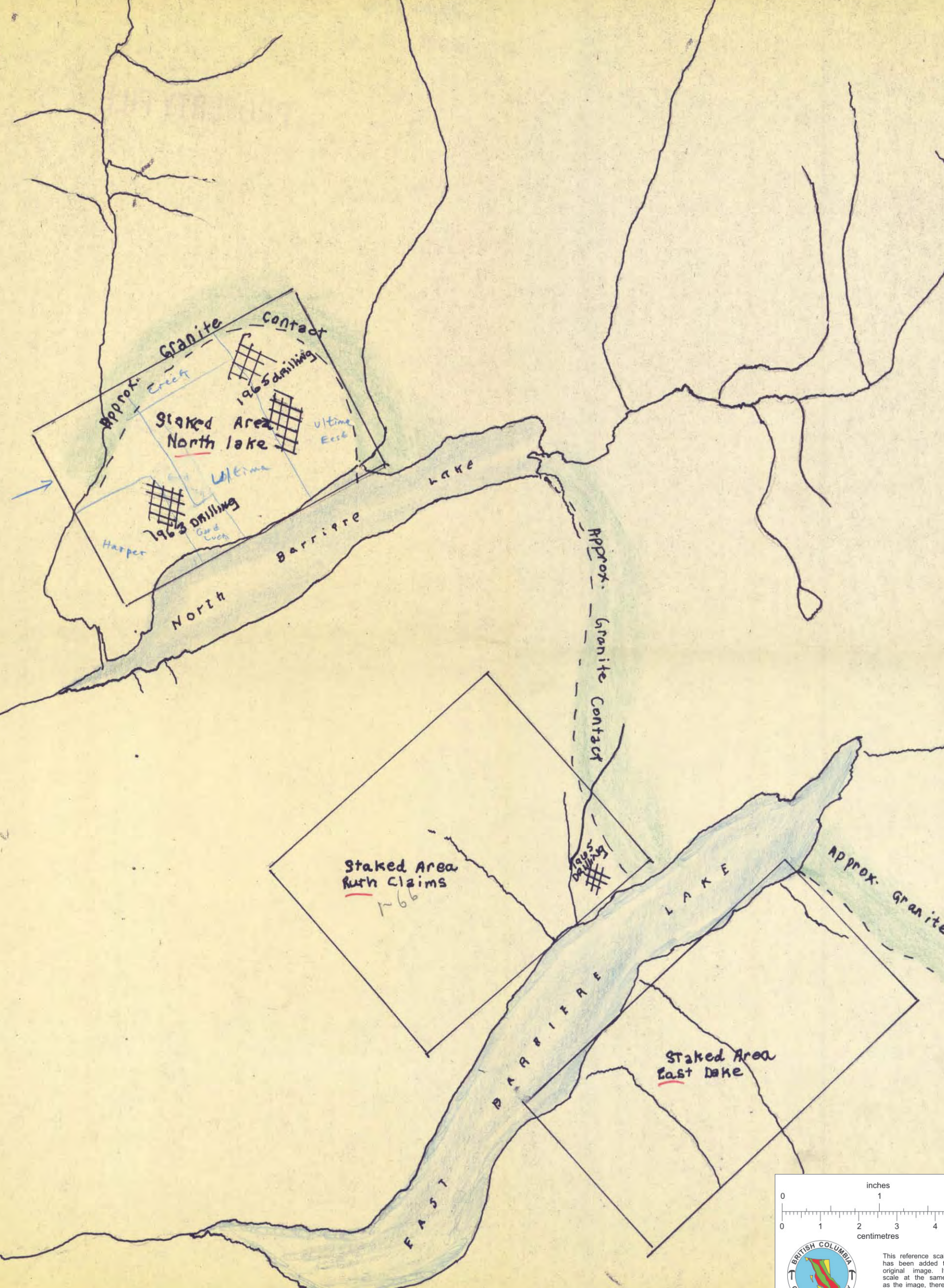
Ruth claims about 8 miles
