

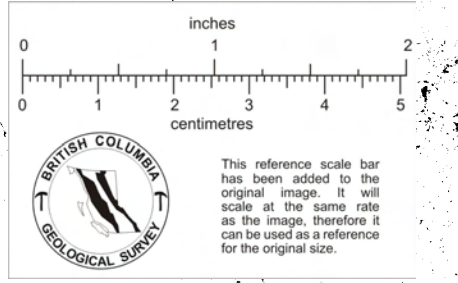
- LEGEND**
- Stream gravels - Glacio-fluvial deposits
  - Cowichan formation - Conglomerates, sandstones, shales
  - Granodiorite, diorite, and related types.
  - VANCOUVER GROUP**
  - Probably Sicker series - Tuffaceous sediments with some volcanic flows.
  - Sutton formation - Limestones, marbles.
  - Principally Vancouver volcanics - Andesitic flows, breccias, amygdaloids, tuffs. Includes Sicker volcanics and, where not differentiated, Sicker sediments.
