 - Sutton formation - Limestones, marbles.
 - Principally Vancouver volcanics - Andesitic flows, breccia, amygdaloid tuffs. Includes Sicker volcanics and, where not differentiated, Sicker sediments.

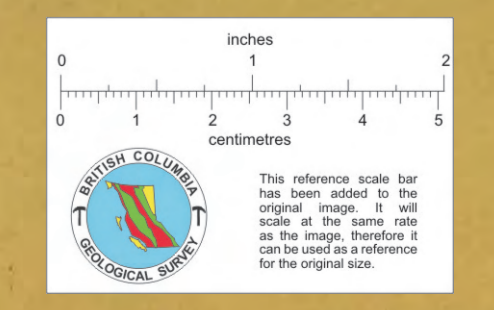
Geology after "Mining Training Project (1939) Mapping". Extensions and outlining of tuffaceous sediments from later reconnaissance mapping.
