A visit was made to the old Silver Leaf property, on Mount Service (north or Cowichan Lake) in company with Mr. Dennis Miller. Three adits have been driven on this copper-gold property (reported to have been driven about 1911 although Mr. Miller said that some work was done during 1942). Mr. Miller advises that their plans are to drive a raise between the two lower levels, which are about 50 feet apart, and "to put in a few rounds at the face". It is planned to drive the raise on a well mineralized area and to possibly ship a small quantity of ore. (Mr. Miller was advised about the need for a "production permit" if ore is to be shipped.)

The property is reached by logging road (McMillan Bloedel Ltd., net Really! Chemainus Division). The last few miles to the property are over "old" logging road. The work, to date, by Mr. Miller has been "brushing out" and repairing the old section of logging road. Mr. Miller was advised that before other work can be done underground some "timbering" will be required at the portal of the lower adit. Otherwise, the ground appeared "good". The upper adit has not yet been located by Mr. Miller and was not inspected.
