The Sentinel showing consists of two replacement deposits in the limestone relatively close to the volcanic contact and about one kilometre northeast of Texada Iron Mines. These deposits, one Pb, Zn, Ag, Au, and the other massive sulphides, may represent a halo effect related to the iron skarns to the southeast. Recent grab samples from old workings and prospect pits have assayed as follows:
