

Note A

This low grade ore is in a fine compact limestone. Is a needle pointed zinc. 15' of this was struck in No. 5 Drill hole (see report). A large body of this is also exposed on Hillside claim. Indicates a continuous band of mineralized limestone running through the Hillside and Roadside claims.

Note B

High grade ore, looks good. Height not determined. more work needed. Chalcopryite, zinc and grey copper noticed.

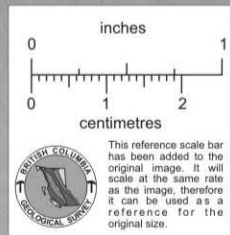
Note C.

Indication of an important ore shoot. Fine looking ore. Further exploration necessary. Chalcopryite, Bornite, Zinc.
