Consists of a group of seven claims situated on the South Westerly Coast of Texada Island. They give surface evidence of an extensively mineralized shear-zone extending through the seven claims from tide water towards Mount Davis.

This zone has been fairly well prospected on the surface by a series of open cuts and shallow pits, some of which are down 12 and 14 feet.

The mineralization is bornite and copper pyrites and this group may turn out to be a large low-grade property easily worked at a low cost and with a short water haul to the works at Ladysmith.

The Government Engineer in the Report of 1925 says:

"The property as a whole would appear to possess considerable merit and warrant further thorough prospecting."
