The Roseanne showing is exposed in the road cut of the access road N of Round Lake, & was formerly covered by the Roseanne 1 & 2 ds. Karmutsen andesite or basalt has been intensely alt. to G-sx sharn, which has been injected by short veins & pockets of qz. Blebs & disseminations of cpy occur in & nr. the qz. of prominent fracture, striking 055° & dipping vertically to 85° NW, may have controlled the altn. & mag. At 40' down the road from the showg. a leasy ls. bed ranging up to 4" thick has an overall attitude of $125^{\circ} 60^{\circ}$ SW.

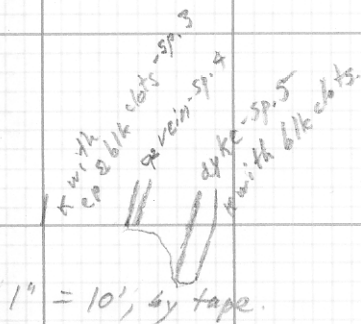
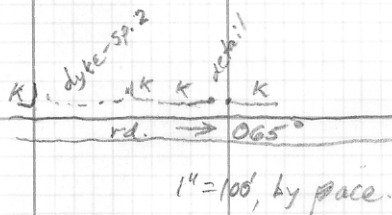
