I have just received a copy of Economic Geology Monograph 5 "The Kuroko and Related Volcanogenic Massive Sulphide Deposits" and was intrigued by the paper starting on page 412 concerning tuffaceous exhalites. In particular the term "tetsusekiei" which, from illustration Fig 2A, refers to what we would have called red chert or jasper appears very similar to material we observed in 1962 on Phillips Creek north of Western Mines. You might be interested in looking at the locality and I enclose a map to show location. Sorry I don't have a better map available.

Maybe someday we will get our claims approved here for which we applied in 1962 prior to designation of the class A Park.

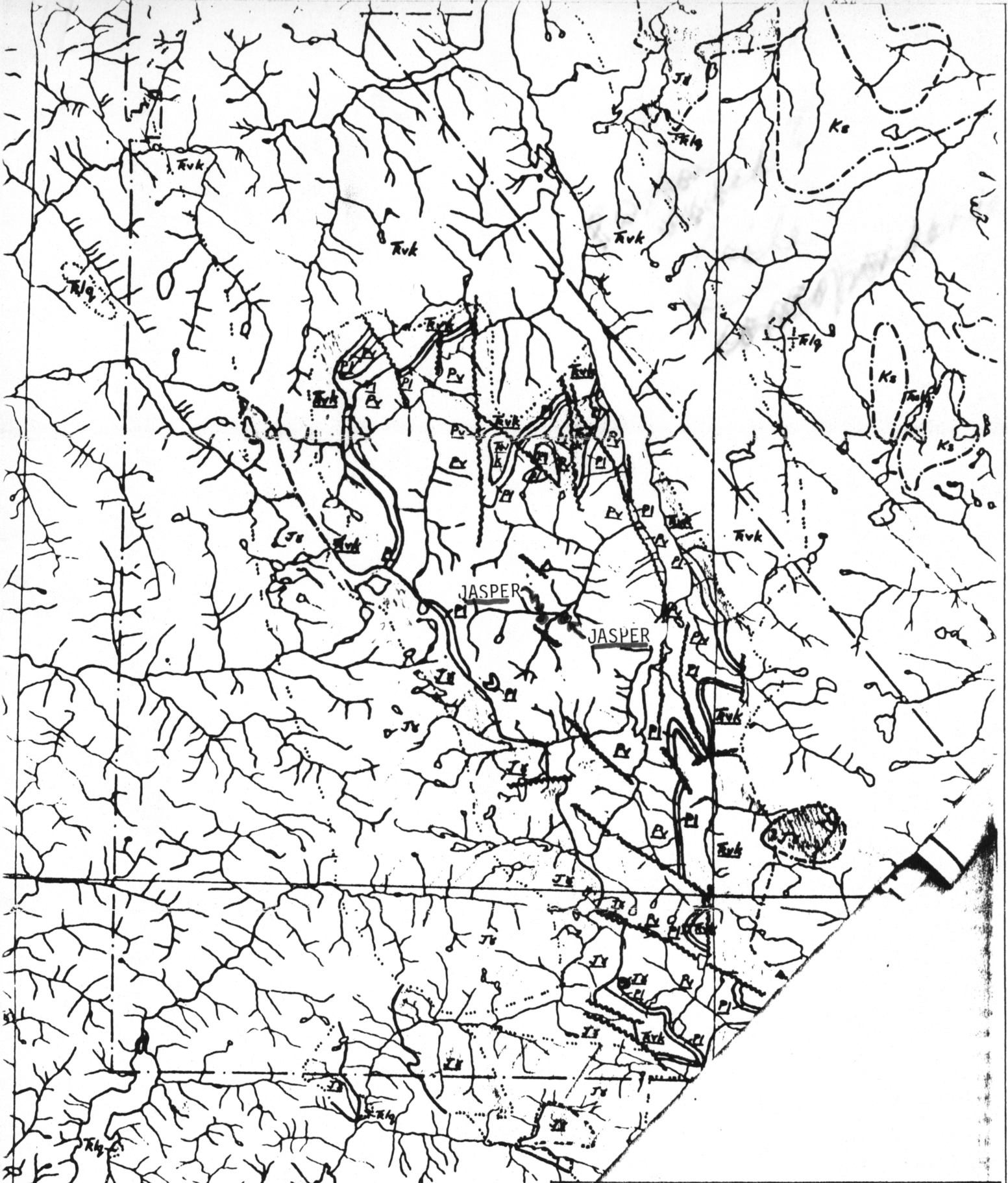
