Re: D D H # 4 - Citex Mines Ltd.

The following are the analytical results obtained at our laboratory from hand specimens of drill core of D D H # 4 of Citex Mines Ltd., which was logged by me in July 12, 1972. The specimens ranged from 2 to 4 inches in length and were taken as representative pieces of 20 to 40 foot sections of core.

On August 9, 1972 the George Cross Newsletter published a company report by Citex Secretary-Treasurer L.P. Price that D D H # 4 assayed 1.10 percent Cu for a 135-foot section between 70 and 205 feet, including a 10-foot section at 5.10 percent Cu, 1.22 oz/ton Ag, and 0.003 oz/ton Au.
