


Mag. & I.P. survey over the Shrike, Bat, and Falcon claims. Percussion drilling by Calico Silver in 1972 on the Falcon and Bat claims. ORE POTENTIAL Low. Cp mineralization observed on Hawk claim related to shearing.
DESCRIPTION: Majority of claim group underlain by Nicola Group rocks
consisting largely of pyroclastics with some interbedded flows. Intrusive
Iron Mask rocks of dioritic composition crop out north of Jocko Lake marking
the margins of the Iron Mask batholith. Chalcopyrite mineralization was
observed along a lineament north of Jocko Lake and at the old Fargo showing
situated on the Edith Lake road(Condor #3 claim). However in both cases the
the mineralization appeared related to narrow shearing. The owner had not
prepared any map locating the showings so we were lead to spots he had found
while staking. Location-wise the claims are excellently situated in relation
to Cominco's AJAX showing, virtually abutting their reported 10 M.T.(0.5%Cu)
deposit. Percussion drilling results of the Calico drilling reported abundant
pyrite in cuttings.
RECOMMENDATIONS: I recommend that C.S.E. do not proceed further with this
property. This recommendation is based on the fact that fairly extensive
work has been done in this area resulting in only one sub-economic showing-
the AJAX. I feel that our exploration monies would be better spent investigating
potentially economic showings north of this area related to proven ore-bearing
