Rainbow Claims, Re: Kamloops, B. C.

As you are probably aware, since 1971 our Rainbow claims at Kamloops have been subjected to considerable exploration and development work by ourselves, Western Mines Ltd. and Getty Mines Ltd. In February of 1974 Getty ceased operations on the property and it has now been fully restored to our control.

A summary of results to date indicate two significant areas of mineralization on the property. Zone 1 contains spazmatic ore intersections which appear to be as yet unconnected and Zone 2 contains a significant tonnage of high grade ore, mainly extending from the 350' level to plus 1200'.

Getty conducted a percussion drilling programme designed to straddle and to test about one mile of strike length on the Sugarloaf Linear. The drill holes were generally spaced at about 300' apart along successive fences, and were drilled to less than 400'. The copper mineralization encountered was generally low grade and usually at depths of 300' or greater. Getty felt that continuance of the programme would undoubtedly necessitate future heavy expenditures for very deep drilling to probe for deeper extentions of the mineral zone, and they did not feel inclined to complete our working agreement.

We are now in possession of all relevant data from day #1 and would be prepared to discuss this property with your firm if you are interested in continuing an exploration programme with us. Please feel free to contact the writer for further information.
