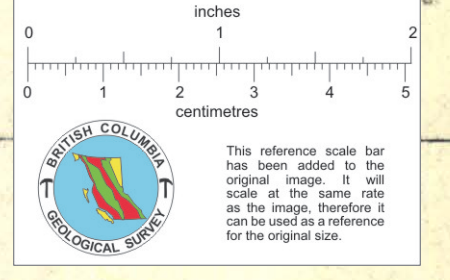
**SYMBOLS**

- PALEOZOIC ROCKS (Silurian or earlier)**  
Sphyerite, basalt, tuffs and conglomerate.
- POST INTRUSIVE (Archaean and (?) later).**  
Muscovite (disseminated chalcopyrite practically ubiquitous.)
- Basalts**
- HYDRA ROCKS (Upper Silurian)**  
Sudbury, may include some altered intrusive or volcanic material in certain areas.
- BOUNDARIES**
- Geologic contact, surface, inferred, assumed.
- Faults and slip of surfaces.
- Strike and dip of joints.
- Strike and dip of mineralized fractures.
- Stream
- Outcrop
- Intersection drill hole.
- Intersection of 2nd QUARTY and 3RD QUARTY.

- Possible Intrusive Bodies
- Pyrite Content Generally Less Than 1%
- Pyrite Content Generally 5-8%
