Please find enclosed a map illustrating the results and an excerpt of a company report dealing with this property. All these claims expired on August 17, 1975.



92ISE OUT In 1979, Fetrequin bought the 9 Al claims, covering the west bank of the Helmer Lake, 1.5 km north of Merritt, B.C. from V.L. Faulger & Associates for \$3,000. The Al claims lie in an area favourable for mineralization, where receptive rocks of the Triassic Nicola formation have been invaded by mineral-bearing intrusives of Jurassic age. Within the Al claim boundaries showings have been uncovered of lead, zinc and copper in limey quartz veins, striking more or less parallel with the schistosity of the Nicola beds. A geochemical soil survey yielded anomalies indicating other zones of copper, zinc and lead mineralization. Sherwin F. Kelly, F. Eng., in his report dated 10Jun83, recommends a program consisting of grid work, magnetometer survey, soil sampling and assaying at a cost of \$27,000.

Petroquin acquired from Melvin Yen the right to buy 8 mineral claims some 45 km 111W of Greenwood, B.C. for 750,000 escrowed shares. Melvin Yen acquired his interest in the property from John Millette, Donald McLeod and James W. McLeod by agreement dated 22-Feb33 for \$500,000 payable over 6 years, of which \$20,000 has been paid.

From 28May83 to 13Jun83, Petroquin carried out geochemical and geophysical surveys over this gold prospect which delineated some anomalous areas. A report by D.A. Howard, P. Eng., and R.H. Seraphim, F. Eng., dated 18Mar83, recommends a 2-phase exploration program consisting of geological mapping, geochemical soil sampling, and
