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Based on government publications and reports by others, Mr. Sookochoff says the Win Zone claims lie within the Nicola Group of rocks which to the south are host to widespread mineralization - the source of which is believed to be the Coast Intrusives. Granitic and related intrusives of the Coast Intrusives are found to the east of the claim block. A pit on the property exposes fractured and faulted silicified limestone with considerable epidote alteration and malachite and azurite staining. A tunnel driven to intersect the mineralization below the shaft was reported to be short of intersecting the mineralized zone. Samples from the dump assayed up to 2.20% copper and 2.30 ounces silver per ton. Chip samples within the pit disclosed values of up to 1.30% copper, 1.50 ounces silver per ton and 4.30% zinc.

Mr. Sookochoff recommended a \$20,000 exploration program consisting of geochemical, induced polarization and magnetic surveys and geological mapping.
