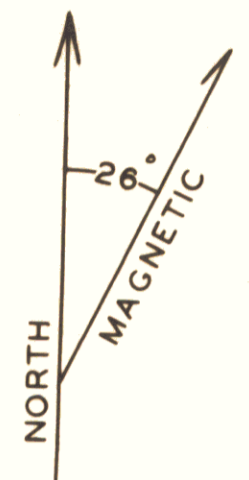


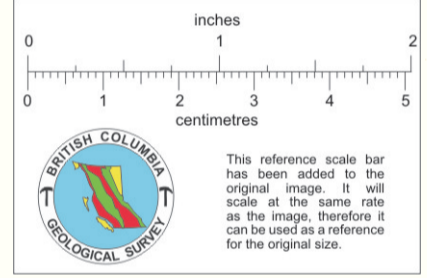
TALUS OF BLUE SERPENTINE CHIPS
