May 10th tunnel in 43' by head (Noel tunnel)

- 0-54 Lagging
- At 98' formation horizontal
- " 116' Quartz stringer assayed 0.08 g. per ton
- " 159' 4" " " no visible mineral
- " ~~220'~~
- " 214' " " 0.01 Au, 0.24 Ag.
- " 220' Considerable quartz in rock
- " 227' 12" quartz stringer 0.14 g. Au.
- " 233' 18" " " Some pyrrhotite (& copper sulphides small amount)
 Sample assayed 0.04 Au, 0.10 Ag.
- " 236' 24" quartz Au, 0.03 Ag, 0.02. Vein strikes N-S,
 dips 45 to 50° to west nearly at right angles
 to the tunnel. Note by A. McLeod "Veins in the
 old workings dip to the east."
- " 277' Quartz stringers plentiful
- " 400' ← Rock is silicified. Au, 0.06. No defined vein. It is
 beyond the first vein exposed on
 surface. The vein is very
 flat, dipping to the east (with
 small amount of work done on it)
 Apparently not important.
- " 406 15" S side of tunnel Au, 0.04.
- At 412 drift 12 ft
 to south 5 1/2 ft
 Au 0.02, Ag 0.08
- " 413-416 5 feet, 0.04 (S side tunnel)
- " 420-423 S side of tunnel Au 0.02
- " 465 Small amount of quartz & iron sulphides in rock,
 Formation dips to the west
- " 523 " slightly " " nearly horizontal
- " 565 " " almost horizontal
- " 593 " almost horizontal
- " 619 8" stringer 0.01 (irregular, unimportant).
- " 633 Two 6" stringers dip to N, strike a few degrees off tunnel strike
- " 630 Au, 0.01, Ag 0.08
- " 683 Formation nearly horizontal. More graphite in rock
- " 712 " striking N.E, slight dip to N.W.
- " 745-746 12" stringer, iron sulphides - strike N 30° W, dip 45° E
 Au 0.005 Ag 0.26 & Au 0.005, Ag, 0.24.
- At 746 drifted 6 ft. south of tunnel
- At 754 1/2 stopped work under company management followed by work
 done on contract (180°?)
- Company work in tunnel resumed in ~~May~~ April 1935.

Diamond-drilling on Golden Cache Group.

June 29/34. No 1 DD hole 270' - Core between 238.5 and 242.5 assayed: - Au, 0.17, Ag, 0.20 - only continuous quartz in hole.

July 6/34 No 2 D.D. hole cut broken rock and water at 250 ft - no vein indications, stopped hole at 260 ft.

July 12/34 No 3 - Stopped at 500 feet. Nothing in cores worth assaying. A few very small quartz stringers in places.

Lot 126

Outcrop of white quartz at 4000' elev. no mineral visible. Sample at ~~with~~ near Nth boundary elev. 3500 ft. Au 0.02 g. per ton.

Surface prospecting on Cache (Golden) claims nothing of importance found - Ground fairly well prospected in early days. All quartz exposures found show signs of former prospecting.

Sample from face of old tunnel 5' long in the bluff below Golden Cache workings on the Golden Eagle claim - Much quartz about the tunnel which was driven in best part of it. Au, trace.

2 men working on Morning Glory Group making open cuts in quartz vein outcropping in creek. The vein is from 10-12 ft wide. Au, 0.01 g. per ton.
