Alt. rdg. 40' at shore of Brown Bay at 12:10 PM.

" " 375' in grl. pit nr. NE cr. of Centre Lk at 12:20

Pick up FS ON line & follow. At abt 10E it crosses 2 forks of a skid rd, then gets lost. Situation would seem to put it somewhere on top of a bluff where alt. rdg. 475' at 1:30 at abt 10E

Angle off uphill to NE, climbing bluffs to alt. rdg. 650', then st uphill, mostly thru salal. At 905' there is a sub-horiz. open fract. in $\frac{1}{2}$; above it rock has pb-like amyggs, & below it is massive. No sign of ls. or Ca stain. Ct. is transected diagonally by 2 qz-up veins, also appar. barren. Ct. is just abt level along contour, but it seems to dip gently into hill.

Time called at 3:30 PM, but photo TX-7 of "amyg" surf.

7 mins walk fr skid rd to SE cr of Centre Lk.

Alt. rdg. 380' back at grl. pit at 4:40 PM.

Directions:-

From Campbell River bridge drive 10 mi N, past the Bloedel industrial site, to the Adams Resort turnoff. Cross Menzies Ck & drive around an unnamed lake & Centre Lk. Watch for logging tracks on 1st part of this rd. Fr. SE cr. of Centre Lk drive on $\frac{1}{2}$ mi. to skid rd on left, & park. Hike up skid rd, taking left branch, to top of 1st bluff. Go to mkr. post at NE cr. of logging. Head for 2d bluff & take it straight on. Take bluff 3 far to left, then bluff 4 abt. st. on. Climb straight upslope to 900' contour & locate $\frac{1}{2}$ of the black-knobbed flow.

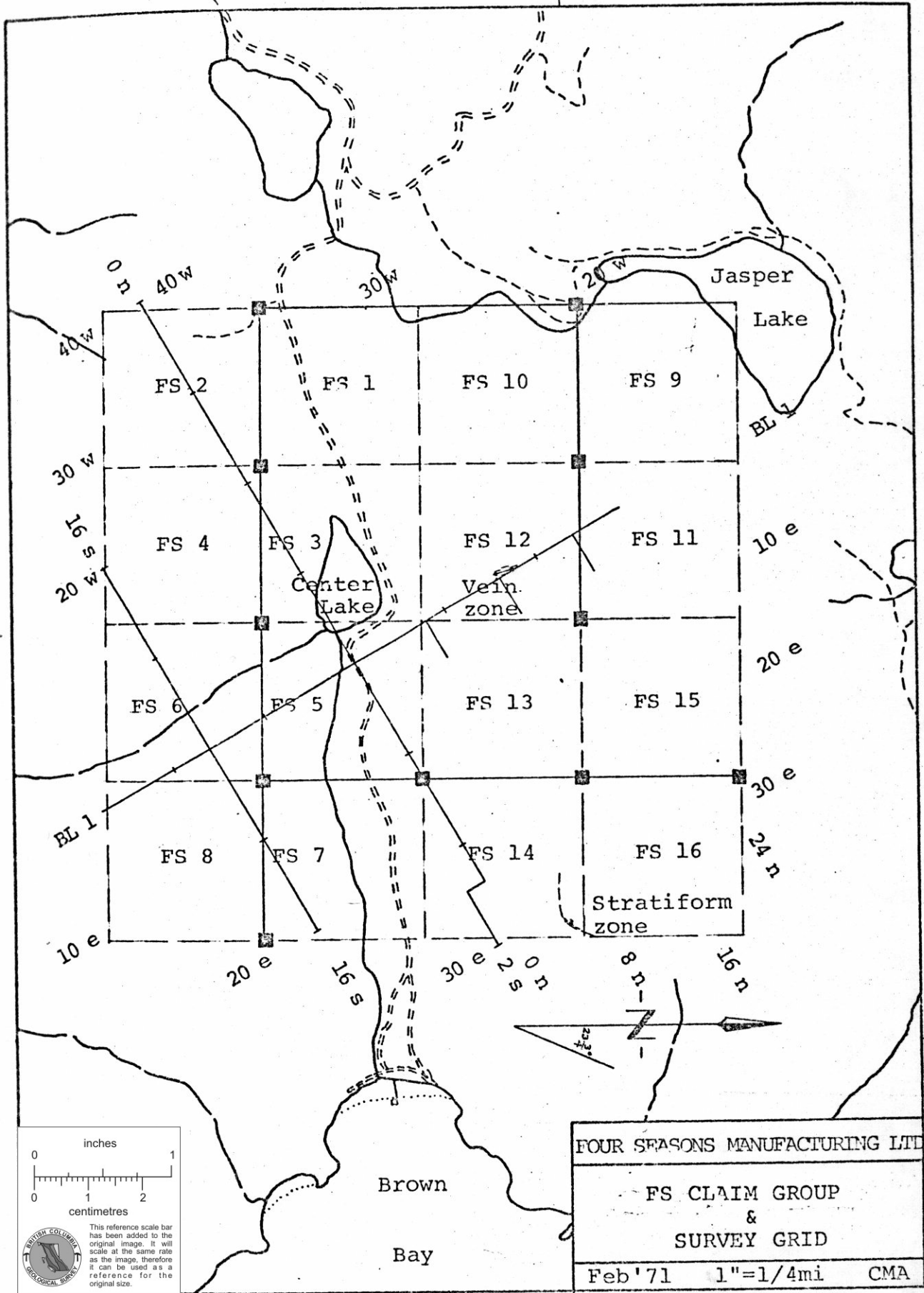

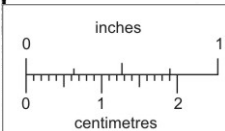
