Re: Nimpkish Property; Nimpkish Lake:

Notes from discussion with Jim Laird, prospector and owner of the CBL Claims (Telephone 462-8047; pager phone 473-7172).

- He has traced the northwesterly trending upland contact of the Nimpkish pluton with Quatsino Limestone and has had considerable success finding skarn mineralization along its lengh.

- He feels that the pluton contact probably has a shallow dip to the southwest and cuts down section to the southwest.

- Storey Creek cuts through limestone and the igneous contact reappears in a canyon zone at a much lower elevation than the upper contact.

- Jim suggests that the lower contact cuts through the Old Sport horizon of the Quatsino Limestone. He is finding good showings of zinc rich skarn.

- He also says that he is finding dykes or sills of intrusion with zin-rich mineralized endoskarn within the main body of the limestone.
