Dear Brian:

Thank you again for your hospitality and the opportunity to visit your property on the Malksope River last month.

I've received X-ray diffraction reports from our own laboratory for two samples I submitted on our return to Victoria. The soft altered material from the Morris C.G. at Monteith Bay which we thought might be the alunite referred to in the old report, turned out to be "quartz, pyrophyllite, and trace amounts of chlorite \pm sericite \pm kaolinite". The soft alteration product on the rhyolitic breccia associated with the quartz stockwork on your property was determined to be "quartz, sericite, and a small amount of chlorite". Sorry, no alunite! However, keep on looking - it's an interesting prospect that's going to require a lot of work. Best wishes.
