Subject: LeMare "Porphyry Copper" deposit

Notes of conversation with Dave Hebelein of Minnova Inc.:

- (1) Mixed results to date. Porphyry part is a weak system. They may be on the east side of a porphyry system with the main part out to sea!
- (2) The epithermal signatures are good but there isn't as much silica or brecciation as they would like to see. They have not had a lot of good numbers for gold.
- (3) The Company is waiting for the results of a lithogeochemical survey.
- (4) The Company is ready to drill a 2000 metre programme but is likely to be held back by fire hazzard. They hope to be drilling by September. Dave will give me a call ahead of time.
