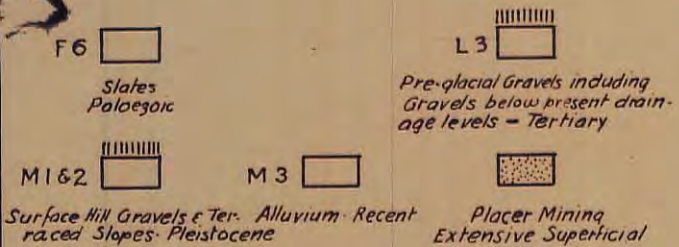


LONGITUDINAL SECTION OF OPENINGS ON WASHBURNE LEDGE

Vertical Scale equal to Horizontal 1/4 in. to 100 Feet Approx.

Shaft in old Tunnel (furthest South & West) 40ft deep which intersected a cross ledge 3 to 4 ft wide & yielded 100 tons of good ore.

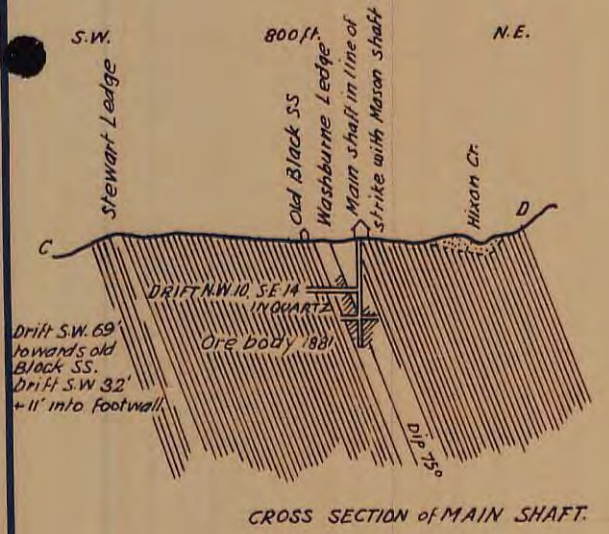


Contour lines Datum level (heavy contour) 2500 Ft. above sea level
Vertical interval, 50 feet between solid lines; 10' between dotted lines

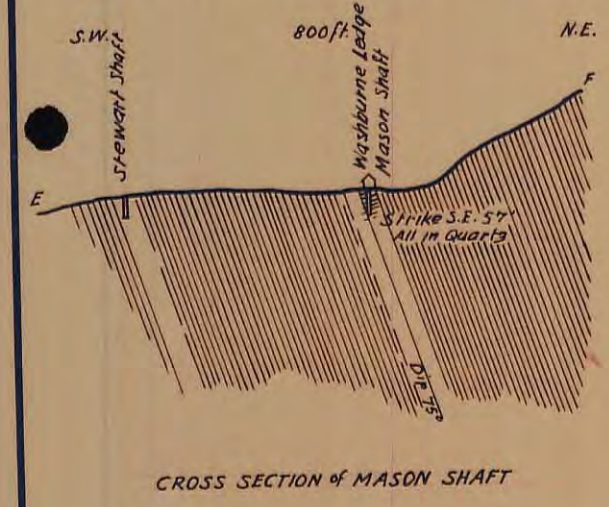
EXPLANATION

In the color scheme it will be observed that the several different formations of gravels, & fragmental matter of the old and present river valleys, embracing the Cainozoic subdivisions are indicated by fragmental lines or dots.

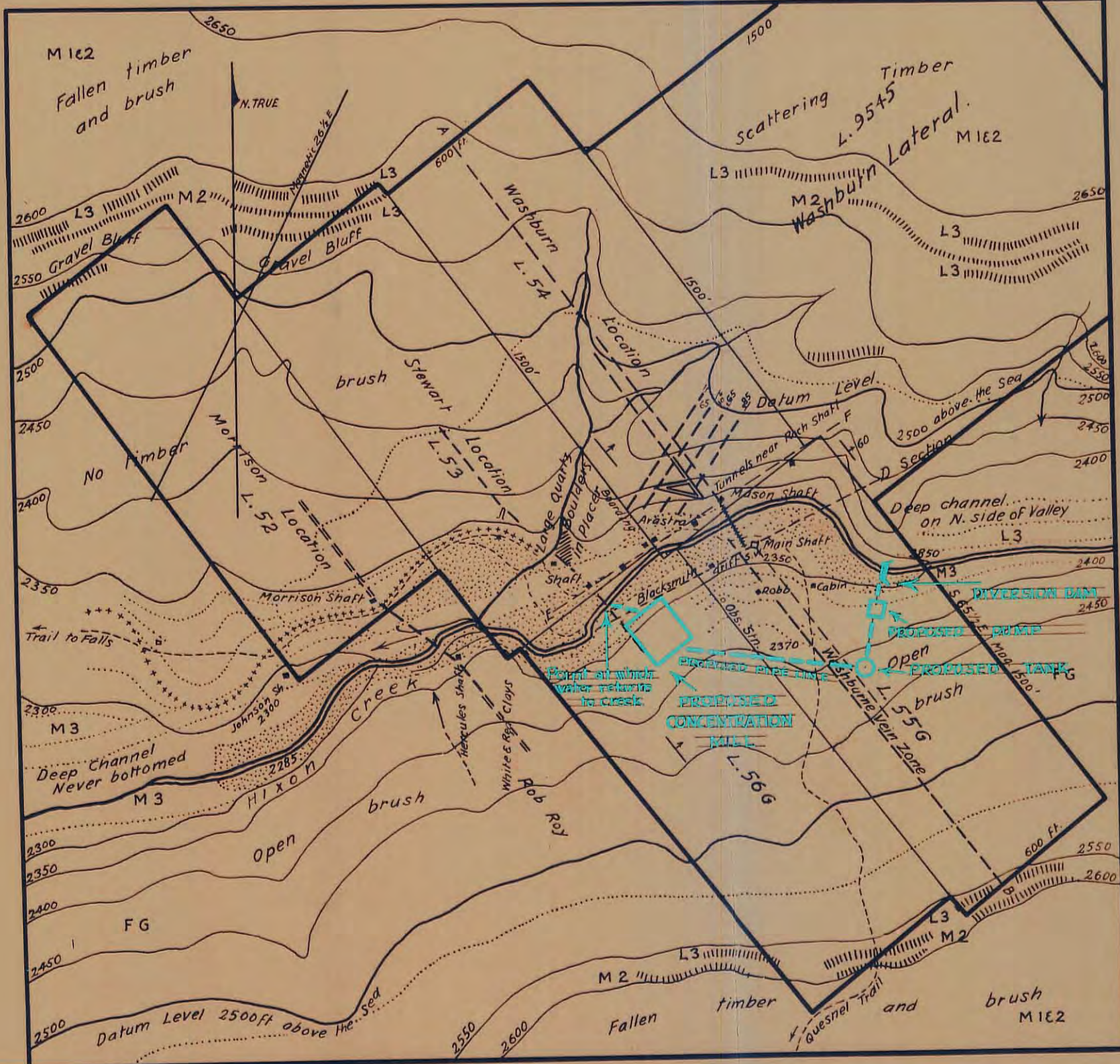
NOTE - The deep channel L-3 marks the position of a tertiary valley which was filled up with pre-glacial drifts, and partly re-excavated by the present stream.



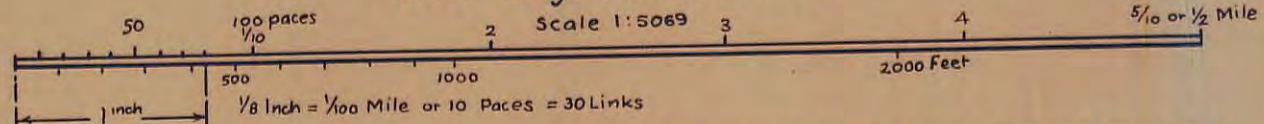
CROSS SECTION OF MAIN SHAFT.



CROSS SECTION OF MASON SHAFT

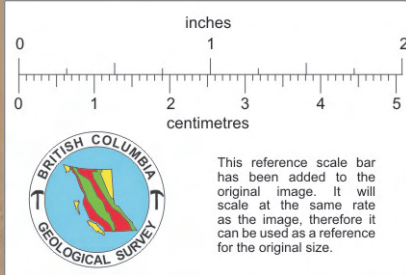


DETAIL MAP OF QUESNELLE QUARTZ MINING CO. MINERAL CLAIMS
