This hole is solid right
to break then - made no water
except at gravel - no indication of
water cracks in rock

215' - makes small amount of
water - probable fault

Record of zone beneath lake
could best be shown on a
series of closely spaced (25-50')
vertical sections // to coordinates

no large fault known to be in Mts area.
though one always has been considered to
cut across somewhere thru here

2' - 2.5' bed resting
on 10' further
5' replacement in
here - still continuing

Plunge 22° NW.
Dip 2° 45' NE.

Assays are better than 200 - with
much samples 1/2 3/4 depending on
amount of dilution

Gravel & fine gold
from 100' to 150' on
E. side of lake
thin extends 60'
into Baker mine
on the level
