## **CLIFTON RESOURCES LIMITED**

Clifton Resources Limited holds an option on 46 mineral claims which cover a four mile strike length of the Rainbow-Baker contact. This contact is the host of two former major gold mines; the Cariboo Gold Quartz and Island Mountain Mines located five miles northwest of Clifton's claims in the Barkerville area of British Columbia. Production from these mines between 1933 and 1967 totalled 3 million tons of ore averaging 0.428 oz. Au per ton.

Previous work on the Clifton property discovered numerous gold-bearing quartz veins and during the 1930's several short adits were driven. The Warspite adit is reported to have exposed a vein 60 feet in length assaying 0.40 oz. Au per ton across 2.8 feet and the Newberry adit 5,000 feet to the south is reported to have exposed a vein assaying 0.80 oz. Au per ton across 8 feet. Southwest of Grouse Creek, on which major placer gold operations were undertaken, early prospecting located a vein 110 feet in length averaging 0.327 oz. Au per ton over a 2.15 foot width. A vein sampled in this area in 1983 assayed 0.49 oz. Au per ton over 8 feet.

During 1983, Clifton completed a detailed soil geochemical survey over the claims. This work outlined major gold anomalies along a two mile strike length of the Rainbow-Baker contact. The company plans a \$100,000 trenching and diamond drilling programme to further explore these areas during 1984.
