says the claims contain extensive old placer operations and quartz veins which occur in the
adjacent slopes. Preliminary geological and geochemical surveys are now in progress.

On Clifton's other Barkererville area property, the Proserpine property, located 5 miles SE of the Cariboo Gold Quartz mine, work completed during 1983 outlined numerous gold-bearing quartz veins and strong geochemical gold anomalies along the 4-mile length of the claims. A \$100,000 trenching and diamond drill program is scheduled to start here before mid-July.

DRILL TEST STARTED ON A - Bruce E. Spencer, P.Eng., a director of Clifton Resources Limited, reports that diamond CARIBOO GOLD PROSPECT drilling on their Proserpine gold properly in the Wells-Barkerville area of B.C. has started. The initial drilling will be concentrated along a 1500 foot strike length where trenching in 1983 exposed gold-bearing quartz veins with values as high as 0.442 ounce gold per ton across 6.2 feet. Geological and geochemical surveys on Clifton's Devils Canyon property, also located in the Wells, B.C. area, have

been completed and results are being evaluated.
