Aerial Trams. New Top Terminal, Rightaway 40 ft wide for  
3980 ft long with 3 towers, + Lower Terminal

Mill Camp water Corralled in Buck + Spring 1100 ft of pipe line  
from Concrete dam in Creek 200 4" + 900 3" Wood Stave

Mill Building having floor space 150 ft long x 30 wide

Power House for 120 direct Connected Garbantes Motor  
Full Equal to 90 KVA Gener  
+ 80 Hp direct Connected to 60 KVA Generator
