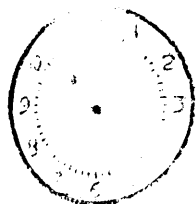

Dear Sir: Re: Bodine Claims - Omineca M.D., B.C.

Pursuant to Section 52(2)(b) of the Mineral Act on submitting a report of the exploration and development carried out on a mineral claim that has been abandoned or allowed to lapse, I hereby advise you of our forfeiture of the Bodine 25 to 31 claims (Record Nos. 444275 to 444282 incl.) which expire on January 10, 1976.

The exploration program conducted on these claims consisted of mapping, detailed silt and soil sampling (631 soil samples along 11 line-miles of grid), and 8.6 line-miles of EM surveying. The total program amounted to approximately \$27,000. Enclosed are a claim location map, geology map, and silt and soil sample site location map.
